

WEST PENNSBORO TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-05

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS ON CROSSROAD SCHOOL ROAD (T-438) IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST PENNSBORO TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of West Pennsboro Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION 1

The following motor vehicle speed limits are established on Crossroad School Road (T-438). All vehicles operating on said road or portions of said road shall operate at or below the speed limits established hereunder.

<u>Road</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Speed</u>
Crossroad School Rd. (T-438)	From its intersection with Creek Rd. to its intersection with Newville Rd. (S.R. 0641).	35 Miles per hour
Crossroad School Rd. (T-438)	From its intersection with Newville Rd. (S.R. 0641) to its southern Watson Dr. intersection.	35 Miles per hour
Crossroad School Rd. (T-438)	From its southern Watson Dr. intersection to its intersection with Kerrsville Rd.	30 Miles per hour
Crossroad School Rd. (T-438)	From its intersection with Kerrsville Rd. to its intersection with the Ritner Highway (S.R. 0011).	25 Miles per hour
Crossroad School Rd. (T-438)	Turn Sign #1	20 Miles per hour
Crossroad School Rd. (T-438)	Turn Sign #2	15 Miles per hour

Crossroad School Rd. (T-438)	Turn Sign #3	25 Miles per hour
Crossroad School Rd. (T-438)	Turn Sign #4	20 Miles per hour
Crossroad School Rd. (T-438)	Turn Sign #5	20 Miles per hour
Crossroad School Rd. (T-438)	Turn Sign #6	20 Miles per hour
Crossroad School Rd. (T-438)	Turn Sign #7	15 Miles per hour
Crossroad School Rd. (T-438)	Turn Sign #8	15 Miles per hour
Crossroad School Rd. (T-438)	Turn Sign #9	15 Miles per hour
Crossroad School Rd. (T-438)	Turn Sign #10	20 Miles per hour

The aforesaid speed limits are hereby established in accordance with a Speed Restriction Study dated July 2010, which is on file with West Pennsboro Township.

SECTION 2
PENALTY

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be subject to such fines and penalties as are established under the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, PA. C.S.A. Title 75, as amended.

SECTION 3
SEVERABILITY

In the event any portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional, all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4

All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.


