

ORDINANCE 93-01

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF LAUGHLIN MILL ROAD (T-406) IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST PENNSBORO, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS the owner of all that land abutting the hereinafter described section of public road has requested that the same be vacated and has agreed to release the said Township from any and all damages arising as a result of said vacation.

AND WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors of West Pennsboro Township has determined that the vacation of the said road is in the best interest of the said Township.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of West Pennsboro Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, does hereby enact and ordain as follows:

All that certain section of T-406, known as Laughlin Mill Road, beginning at the south side of the former Pennsylvania Railroad underpass and extending southwardly to its terminus, a distance of 5000 feet, more or less, is hereby vacated as a public highway, and all right, title, and interest of the Township of West Pennsboro therein is hereby divested.
