ORDINANCE NO. 96-02

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING THE DIRECTION OF MOTOR VEHICLE
TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN STREETS IN WEST PENNSBORO TOWNSHIP,
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained by the Board of Supervisors of West Pennsboro Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, that the following roads or portions of roads located within West Pennsboro Township shall be restricted in the permitted direction of vehicular movement as follows:

SECTION 1. Restrictions on Operation of Motor Vehicles

<u>Township Road</u>	<u>Direction of Permitted Traffic</u>
BACK STREET (T-457) from Greason Road (T-451) to E. Main Street (S.R. 0641)	Eastwardly

SECTION 2. Penalty.


Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be subject to a civil fine in the amount of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and shall, in the event legal action shall be necessary for the prosecution of such violation or the collection of such fine, such person shall also pay all Court costs and the reasonable legal fees incurred by the Township as a result of such legal action.


SECTION 3. Severability.
