

**RESOLUTION 2011-07**

A RESOLUTION OF THE SUPERVISORS OF WEST PENNSBORO TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA (hereinafter "the municipality").

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted there under, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, the West Pennsboro Township Municipal Authority has prepared an "Act 537 Plan Update" which provides for sewage facilities in a portion of West Pennsboro Township, and

The alternatives recommended for implementation include an upgrade/expansion to the existing wastewater treatment plant and extension of collection and conveyance facilities to serve areas of future development. The timeframe for which the recommended alternatives will be implemented will be based upon Chapter 94 Waste load Management projected overload conditions and development activity in the Township. All new facilities will be owned by the West Pennsboro Township Municipal Authority, and operated by Township staff per the Lease-Back Agreement between West Pennsboro Township Municipal Authority and West Pennsboro Township.


WHEREAS, West Pennsboro Township finds that the Facility Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Supervisors of the Township of West Pennsboro hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Plan" of the municipality, the above referenced Facility Plan. The municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).
